

**GARY DEWEY
DEW DAD**

- Hook: Mustad 37160 Size: 6 (or 4)
Straighten hook over barb and flatten out with fingers
- Thread: Danville .06 (olive or green)
Start at eye and wrap the width of the eye back
- Body: Tie in 2 pieces of old fly line on sides of hook to point even with barb
flatten out after tied in on both sides
build a thread ball at tail end of flyline point
- Nostral: strip a ring neck pheasant feather down to a 1/4" point
tie in facing tail end for nostral
- Antenna: Tie in 2 clear microfibbets at tail end (using whole length of fibbet)
Secure with an underwrap
- Pinchers: 2 ring neck pheasant feathers stripped down to pincher size
use scissors to clip out tip of feather
coat with Dave's Flexament by rubbing on fingers and sliding through
tie a pincher on each side of hook
- Carpaesis: tie in brown scud back at mid hook facing the tail end
tie in .010 lead and wrap 15 turns from tail to middle of hook
secure with thread wraps over lead
- Body: Tie in 10 peacock hurls and use tie in to build up body
- Legs: Tie in a big webby grizzly hackle on top of peacock
- Then: Wrap peacock in a strand to middle of hook
tie off and wrap thread back through peacock
4 wraps of hackle, weaving into peacock body and tie off at mid hook
pull scud back over and secure at mid hook
Wrap more peacock all the way to the eye of the hook
reinforce peacock with thread wraps
make 5 segments in scud back as you pull over peacock
Whip finish twice
Cut scud back in a fin shape at hook eye
